How to Change Accounts

Changing to Patriot Bank is easier than you might think. If you don't currently bank with us, these simple steps will help you close your current account and move your money into a Patriot Bank account.

Step One:

Open Your Patriot Bank Checking and Savings Accounts

Complete the Customer Account Profile and return it to us. There will always be a friendly face at one of our locations to assist you with account opening. Temporary checks are available immediately and we'll order your first box of Patriot Bank checks FREE with Direct Deposit.

Step Two:

Move Your Money

Calculate the amount of money needed to cover all outstanding checks, automatic payments, and service charges from your old checking account. Leave that total amount plus a small cushion in the account. Then write a check for the remainder and deposit it into your Patriot Bank checking account.

Step Three:

Paycheck Direct Deposit

If your company offers Direct Deposit, complete the paycheck Direct Deposit authorization and return it to your payroll department. Your net pay will then be automatically deposited to your designated Patriot Bank account each payday morning. Instead of a paycheck, you'll receive a pay stub showing your earnings and deductions. To get cash, simply write a check or visit an ATM terminal.

Step Four:

Convert Your Automatic Payments

If you have preauthorized payments from your old checking account, you'll need to notify the companies to begin taking the payments from your new Patriot Bank checking account. It could take a full billing cycle for some companies to adjust their records, so you may need to keep enough money in your old account to cover preauthorized payments. A voided check or deposit ticket from your Patriot Bank checking account contains the numbers necessary to make the change.

Step Five:

Convert Any Other Automatic Deposits

If you have other automatic deposits, contact the issuer with your new Patriot Bank checking account information. A voided check or check deposit ticket from the new account contains the numbers necessary to make the change.

Step Six:

Close Your Old Account

Once your automatic payments have been converted and all outstanding checks have cleared your old account, contact your former bank. To close your account, you can either write a final check from the account or ask the bank to send you a check for the remaining balance.
